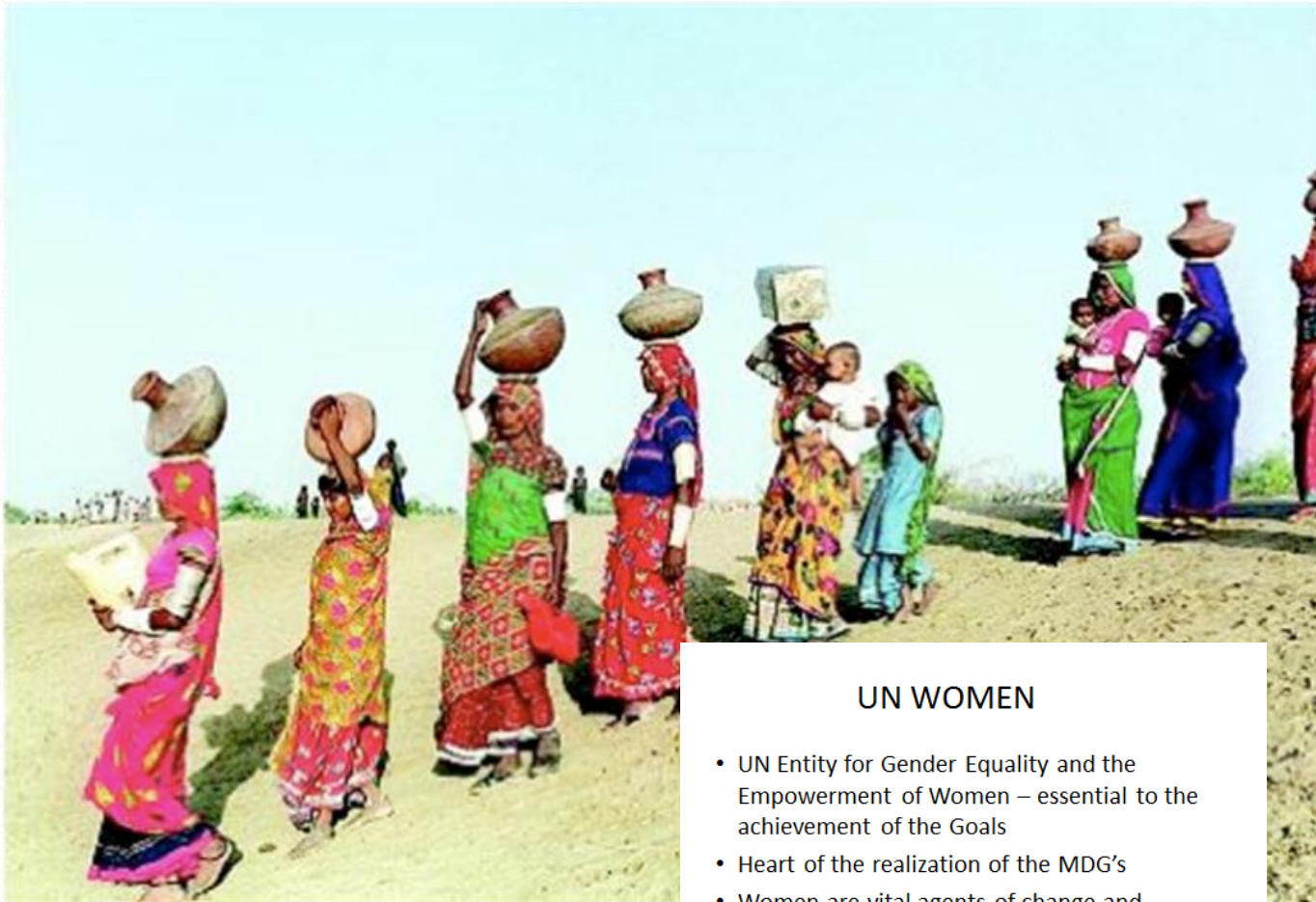

Polluted Water: Problem



Fecal Contaminated Water KILLS

- 1.1 Billion in need of clean water
- 1 in 5 children under 5 die
- 2 of remaining 4 have disabling illness
- Water diseases account for 80% illness in developing countries
- Diarrhea from fecal contaminated water is the 2nd highest cause of child's death.

Direct correlation between unsafe unclean water and poverty.

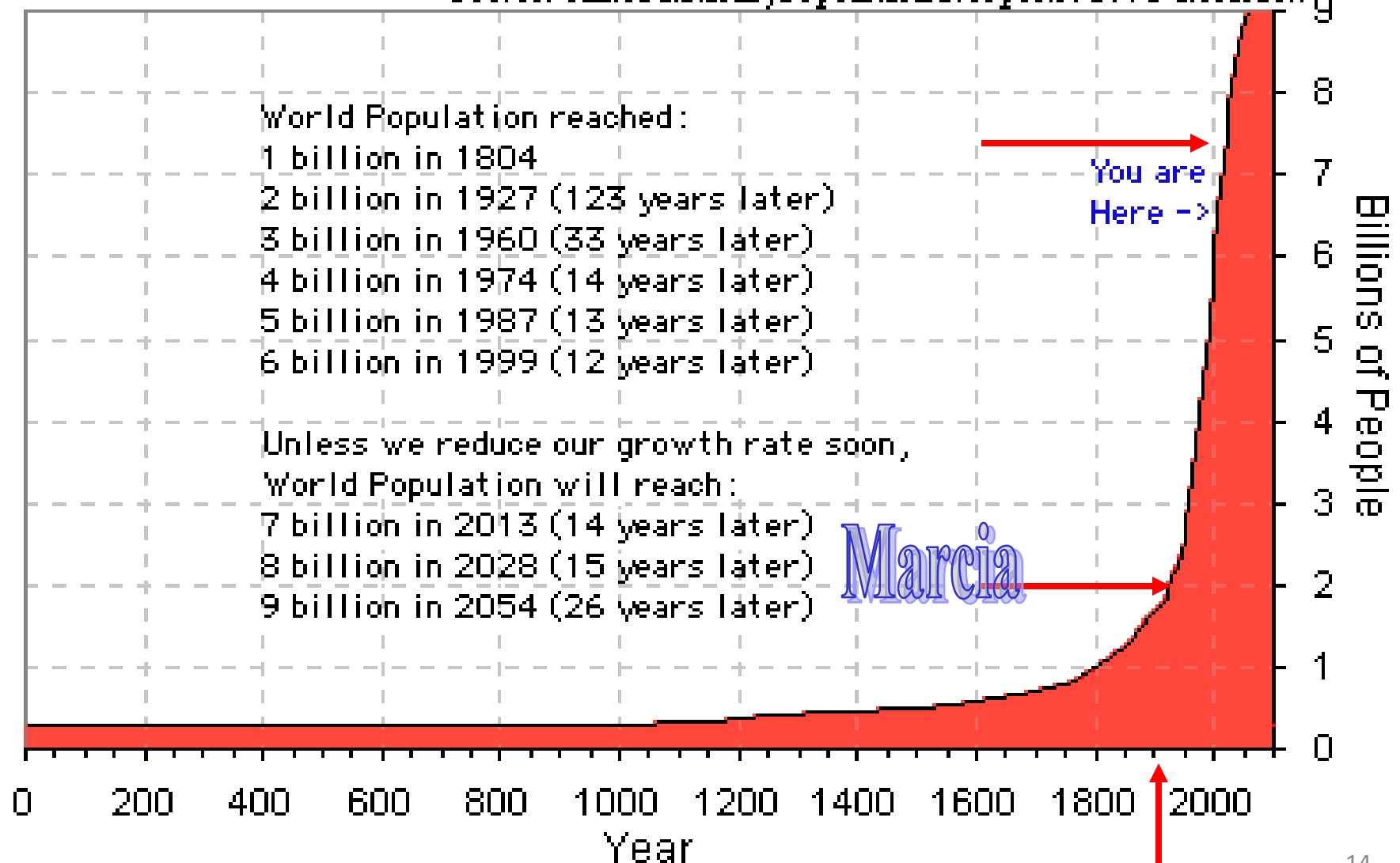
Common Water Sources

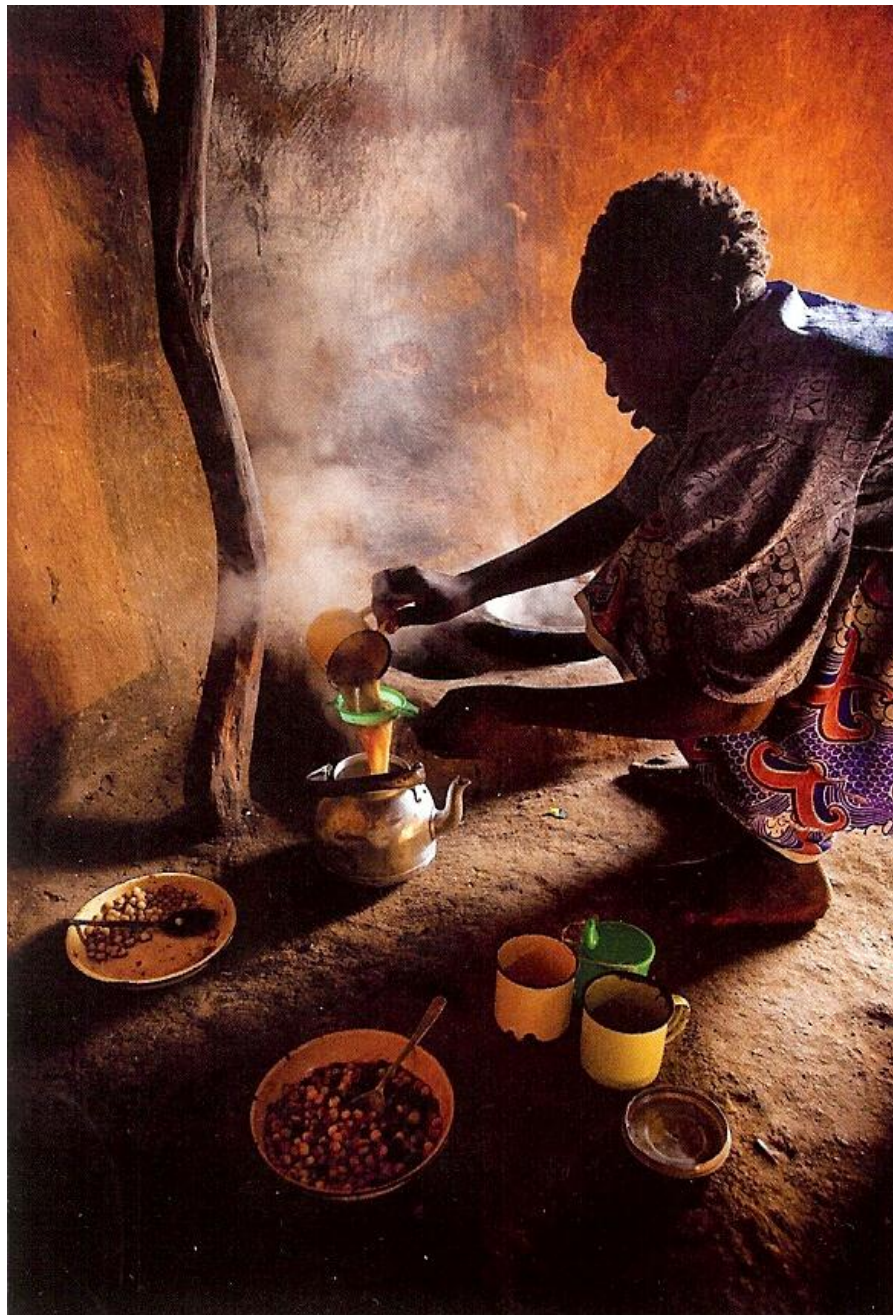




GLOBAL POPULATION WATER SCARCITY

SANITATION



Dual stall Eco Latrine – liquid and solid – with containers that will pull out at ground level and can be used as compost

- **Without access to a latrine, girls stop attending school once they reach puberty.**
- **2.5 billion People lack access to adequate sanitation.**
- **40% of world pop do not have adequate sanitation**

Health & Hygiene

- WASH YOUR HANDS!
- Separate fecal matter from living space
- Use Clean (sanitized) containers to collect clean water
- Minimize flies around food, cover food
- Hydrate when children have diarrhea
- Instruct
- Survey
- Test water supply
- Test water from filter
- Observe safe water practices

Role of Women in Global Development



Women: Water at the Core

- Women fetch and carry the water
- They cook, clean, maintain sanitation
- Collect wood to boil water and prepare food
- 90% done by women, and daughters
- Educate children about water: Wash hands
- Care for sick children
- Responsible to feed the family

Women and Farming

Women and Global Development

Women and global economic and political stability

- Poverty, racism and the systematic oppression of **women** contribute to political and economic instability around the world.

What is being done

World Bank: Women in Development

- By 2010, at least half of the Bank's rural and agricultural projects, expected to total US\$800 million, will address a gender concern;
- The World Bank Group will channel at least US\$100 million through the IFC towards women entrepreneurs by 2012;
- The International Development Association (IDA) will increase investments for gender equality
- Innovative engagements with foundations and the private sector will help boost women's economic empowerment.



The Aqua Clara Water Purifier

- Uses Local Materials, Local Talent, Local Revenue
- Adequate for family of 6
- Requires no power
- Has no moving parts
- Will last 10 years, minimal care
- Cost for materials is \$15-25
- Meets WHO Standards
- Begin with trust relationship
- Technology transferred free
- Certificate with training for licensed Business Creation
- Sustainable, Indigenized, Job Creation





The standard AC Water Purifier will filter and disinfect water contaminated with parasites, bacteria and other sources of waterborne-related disease. These issues constitute the main of worldwide water contamination problems. Units of special design are being developed and will be made available to locations dealing with other sources of water contamination - including heavy metals, chemicals, etc. (such as arsenic, mercury or fluoride)

HOW IT WORKS

Source water is collected as normal and then poured through the purifier. A complex process of biological, mechanical and chemical filtration and disinfection takes place, producing enough safe, clean water to meet a family's needs.

A DIFFUSER PLATE is used so that filler layers are not disturbed by poured water.

The SOURCE WATER pushes down through the filler layers.

The BIOLOGICAL LAYER is where the majority of parasites and bacteria are eliminated. It is constituted of living material and feeds on contaminants.

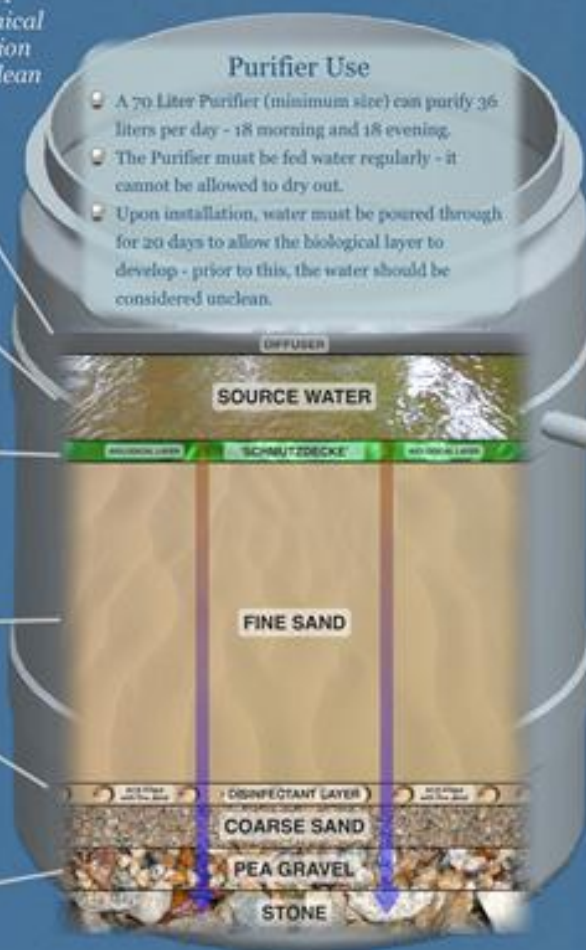
The FINE SAND LAYER is where mechanical filtration strains out additional contaminating material.

The DISINFECTANT layer is where a granulated metallic biocide eliminates remaining contaminants.

The BOTTOM 3 LAYERS simply allow for a free flow of water into the collection pipe. If easier, gravel may replace the stone layer.

Purifier Use

- A 70 Liter Purifier (minimum size) can purify 36 liters per day - 18 morning and 18 evening.
- The Purifier must be fed water regularly - it cannot be allowed to dry out.
- Upon installation, water must be poured through for 20 days to allow the biological layer to develop - prior to this, the water should be considered unclear.



The CONTAINER used can be whatever type available, as long as it is at least 70 L capacity and of a durable HDPE plastic.

The PIPING is constructed of carefully measured and cut 1/2" PVC sections. Tight seals must be achieved to prevent leaks.

THE PURIFIED WATER must be collected in a different container than the one collecting source water. It should be cleaned regularly and kept covered.

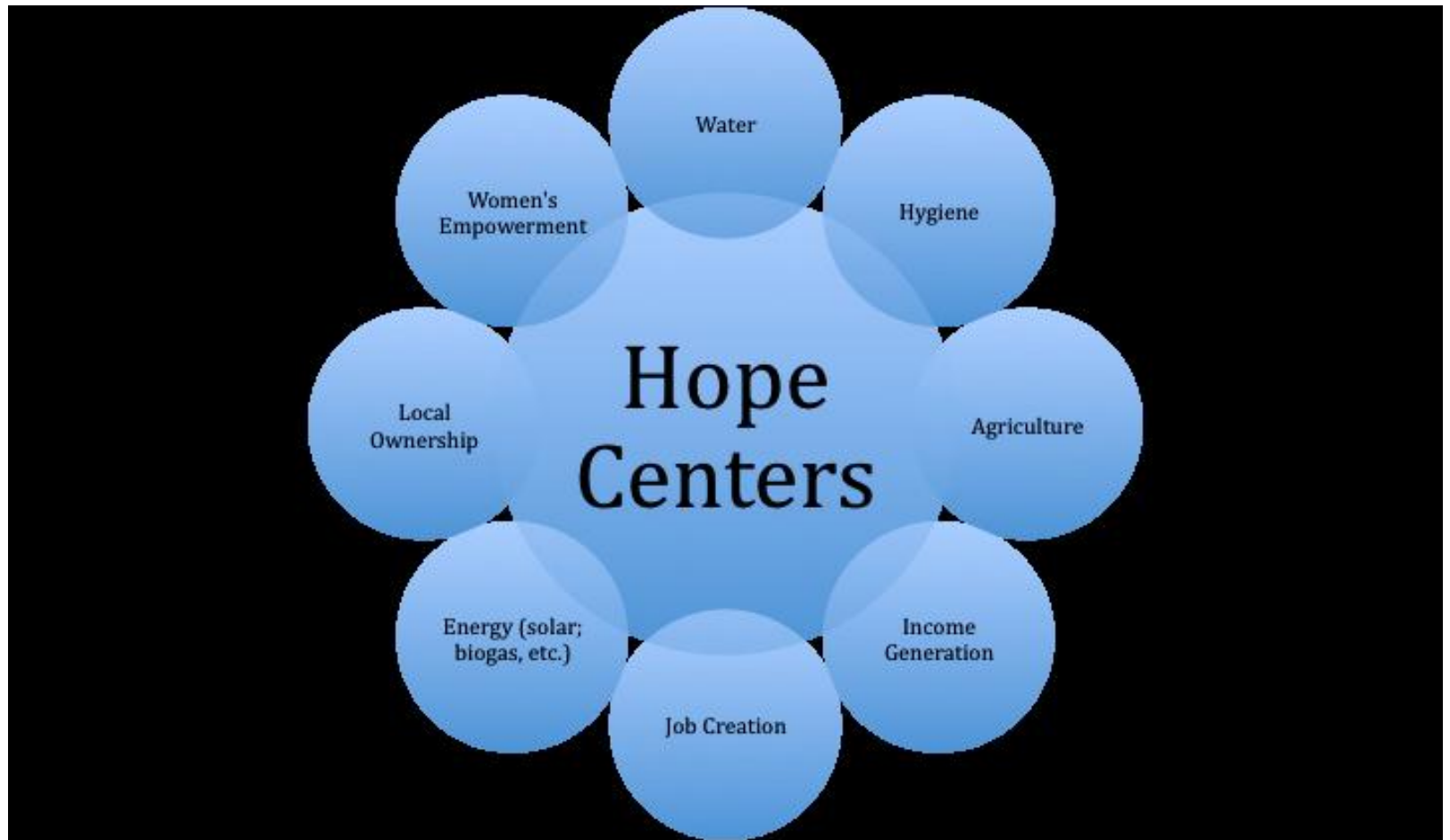

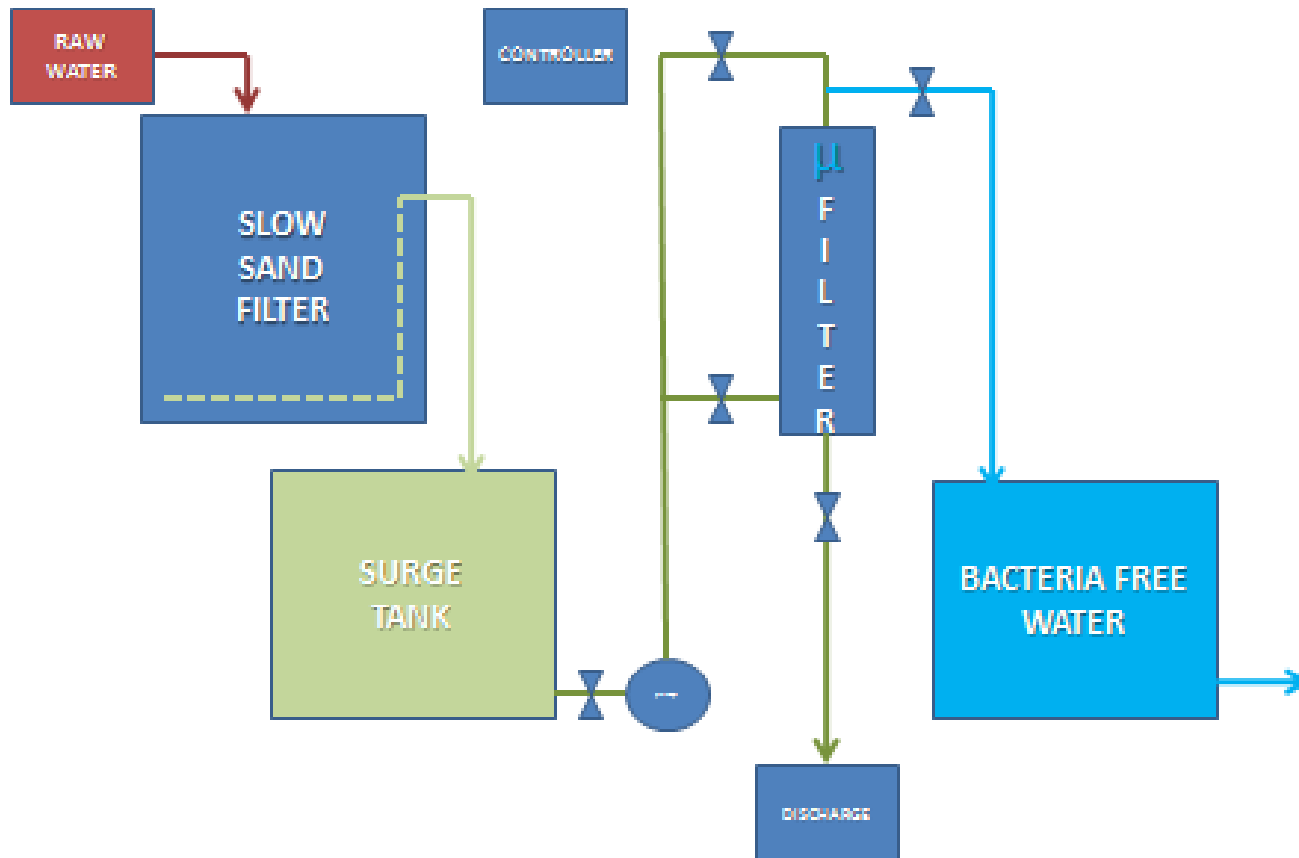
